### Take A Spin

Once considered the world's carousel-making capital, Philadelphia packs plenty of merry-go-round fun. On the **Philadelphia Park Liberty Carousel** in Franklin Square (200 N. 6th St., 215.629.4026), the animal-inspired figures include a replica of Smarty Jones, one of Philly's favorite hometown racehorses. Admission costs \$2.50 per person. Illuminated by almost 1,300 lights, the enchanting **Woodside Park Dentzel Carousel** at the Please Touch Museum (4231 Ave. of the Republic, 215.581.3181) is free for kids with museum admission. At the Philadelphia Zoo (3400 W. Girard Ave., 215.243.1100), the "seats" on the all-wooden **Amazon Rainforest Carousel** resemble jaguars, anacondas and exotic species. Tickets cost \$3 per person.
